Submission Guidelines

Papers should be submitted electronically to http://ier.ut.ac.ir. Upon receipt of the paper, a confirmation e-mail will be sent electronically.

- 1- All manuscripts should be submitted in word 2007 format (also PDF) with 1.5 line spacing and should not exceed 28 pages (a 35 page limit applies to double- spaced manuscripts). This limit includes reference lists, figures, and tables.
- 2- Please use 12- point **Times New Roman** or Similar font. Margins should be 1.5 inches on the top, bottom, and sides.
- 3- Your manuscript should include a title page with each author's name and contact information.
- 4- Include an abstract of 400-500 or fewer words.
- 5- Fully reference all prior work on the same subject and compare your paper to that work. In addition to referencing the work of other scholars, you should be certain to cite your own work when applicable.
