Journal of Research in Applied Linguistic Studies (RALS) invites all Iranian and foreign linguists, applied linguists, and teaching practitioners to contribute to the journal by submitting papers under the following main headings:

- Applied Linguistics
- Literary Studies
- Translation Studies

Manuscript Preparation

Feature articles include theoretical analyses and reports of original research. All the articles should connect theory, research, and practice. Submissions are evaluated along the following criteria:

- Relevance and importance to *RALS* readers
- Adequacy of conceptual framework
- Appropriateness and competence of method
- Reasonableness of interpretations and conclusions
- · Links between theory, research, or policy and practice
- Clarity of organization and vigor of style
- Originality of contribution

A manuscript must follow the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA)*, fifth edition. It should be about 2,500 to 7,000 words in length, including references and an abstract of 100 to 150 words. Manuscripts should not have been submitted to another journal or published elsewhere.

Writing Style

RALS follows the writing style recommendations of chapters 2 and 3 in the *APA Manual*, fifth edition. Manuscripts should be written for clarity so that implications are comprehensible to practitioners as well as to researchers.

Manuscript Submission

Two copies of the manuscript should be submitted as file attachments to an e-mail message. One copy should include the cover page and author information, and one copy (for review) should have no cover page or author information. If the reviewer functions have been used in manuscript preparation, all tracked changes should be accepted before the file is submitted electronically.

The e-mail message serves the function of a cover letter. It should include all author names and positions as well as contact information for the first author. Acceptable text file formats are Rich Text format (.rtf) or Microsoft Word (.doc), with all figures, tables, and graphs incorporated into the document as text. Images or graphics should be sent as separate files in either .tif or .eps format.

The financial requirements for publication in RALs

According to the formal announcement made by Ministry of Science, Research and Technology, manuscripts submitted to RALs for review and possible publication will be processed only when the following conditions are met:

1. Upon submission to RALs, 50,000 Tomans should be deposited in the bank account number 2177272219000

1. After final acceptance issued by the journal, 100,000 Tomans should be wired into the above bank account for publication as well.

Please make sure that a copy of your payment receipt is attached to your submission as an image file. It should be noted that all deposits are non-refundable.

Review Process

An e-mail message or letter will acknowledge manuscript receipt. If accepted for blind review, the manuscript will be sent to, at least, two readers: Typically, one has broad general knowledge of the field, and one has expertise in the particular topic or methodology. Within six months, authors can expect to receive one of four decisions: (a) manuscript acceptance, (b) acceptance with revision, (c) nonacceptance with an invitation for revision and resubmission for another round of review, or (d) nonacceptance and recommendation for submission to a different publication. Reviewers aim to provide authors with helpful feedback for manuscript revision and future manuscript preparation. Manuscripts that fail to follow submission guidelines will not be reviewed.

Formatting Guideline

Accepted manuscripts should comply with the following formatting for publication:

• Document (paper) size: 17 cm by 24 cm

Margins on all sides: 2.5 cmFont type: Times New Roman

• Font size: 10 pt.

Line spacing: 1.15 (Multiple)
Space before paragraph: 0 pt.
Space after paragraph: 6 pt.

• First line indentation for all paragraphs: 1.27 cm

Paragraph headings should be numbered and made bold.
